

Simplified version of flat design style. Here you won't find detailed images of people or objects, just main accents. It will perfectly fit banners with text blocks: expressing the main idea it doesn't distract viewer's attention from main concepts.






Flat design style with smooth forms accompanied by textures and stylized characters. This version will be suitable in illustrations both with and without text blocks. This type looks stylish with the usage of a limited color scheme.





The example is performed in creative style without textures. It tends to free shapes and can be combined with line elements on the background in dependence of the task.





Isometry is an eye-catching and trendy method which looks great whether you use it for presentations, banners or web pages. What makes this style so popular now is that it combines usual flat design and 3d effect. It has no perspective shortening that's why isometry is widely used in game design.





Line design style is the best way to show the connections between concepts and explain details. It often goes with texts because of its lightness and simplicity. Here we don't use color accents - just the lines.





Unlike the previous image, this composition has smooth free lines. That makes the illustration look like hand-drawn. Color accents can set the mood and draw attention.

Lines can have color fillings. That doesn't make the image look busy but puts accents. In this case the image remains laconic.










We can add even more color to the image and fill all the forms according to your preferences.

COLORS


